SUBJECT: Consolidated List of Fees and Charges for Official Documents and Services

Supersedes: Marine Notice ADM-003, dated 03/22

PURPOSE:

This notice updates the Registrations Publication Package Administrative Fee.

APPLICABILITY:

The Notice is for the information of all owners and potential owners and operators of Liberian flag vessels.

Delivery of documents:

Where applicable, documents will be delivered by email without need for courier fee.

If a hard copy of the document is required, a courier fee of US \$65 will be applied for each courier shipment. Multiple certificates will be combined when possible in one courier delivery to save cost.

Certificates and publications may also be picked up locally or sent by local courier from the Registry's regional offices. A service fee of \$35 will be applied for each shipment picked up locally.

REQUIREMENTS:

The fees in the following Sections are to be remitted by credit card, wire transfer or check.

1.0 Initial Registration Fee and Annual Tonnage Tax

 - Minimum Annual Tonnage tax \$0.41/NRT
(but not less than \$902.00)

2.0 Marine Safety Inspection Compliance Program:

- 2.1 Annual fee for each vessel 500 gross tons or over for funding the Marine Inspection Compliance Program and matters related thereto, as provided by Maritime Regulation 7.191 and Maritime Fee and Taxes Regulation 9\$2, 000
- 2.2 Periodic unscheduled vessel inspection fee following detention, to examine and report on the correction of a deficiency, or for the restoration of documents, etc., or for any additional urgent inspection requested by the operator... ..\$2,750
- 2.3 As indicated in Regulation 9 (5) of the Maritime Fees Regulations, the fee for Marine Inspection shall be adjusted in accordance with the inflation index in the form of the published Producer Price Index (PPI) of the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics with calendar year 1995 being the base year and \$1200 being the base price. Such adjustments may be subject to a delay in application due to delay in the publication of such statistics.

The Office of the Deputy Commissioner will make this adjustment by amendment to this Marine Notice, effective from the date of publication of said amended Marine Notice.

3.0 Marine Investigations

- 3.1 Annual fee payable under Maritime Regulation 2.4 for Marine Investigations and International Participation (MIIPS) for vessels of 14,000 Net Registered Tons and above is:
 - \$.03 per net ton plus \$2,000.
- 3.2 Annual fee payable under Maritime Regulation 2.4 for Marine Investigations and International Participation (MIIPS) for vessels less than 14,000 Net Registered Tons is
 - \$.07 per net ton plus \$1,000.

3.3 While no fees are payable regarding specific Hearings, the Parties and interested persons may be required to pay certain actual costs in connection therewith.

¹ The alternative pricing for vessels of 14,000 NRT and larger is applicable only for vessels entering the registry after July 1,2000.
